When it comes to birth control and family planning, John McCain just says NO:

- NO** to the family planning program that provides millions of women with health care services ranging from birth control to breast cancer screenings.²
- NO** to all federal health grants to any health center that provides abortion care, a move that would defund family planning clinics nationwide.³
- NO** to birth control. John McCain has voted against birth control more than 20 times.⁴

And yet, McCain voted to ban abortion for many women, even in cases of rape, incest, or when a woman’s life is in danger.⁵ He’s even said that *Roe v. Wade* should be overturned.⁶
